Project Description



We recognise the profound nexus between Inclusion and Wellnessevidenced by our work supporting FTSU and EDI leads in the NHS, and offer free wellness webinars to support frontline BAME staff.

The support takes direct account of multicultural and indigenous psychology, and is delivered by a professional coach and counsellor.

Project Description

Many of our social impact projects support communities that our customers service, but this project gave us the opportunity to support a new community.

By early September 2021, over 8,000 refugees from Afghanistan had arrived in the UK. IT was widely reported that the majority fled the country with few possessions.

The Government launched Operation Warm Welcome which is designed to help Afghan refugees rebuild their lives, find work, pursue education and integrate into their local communities.

Working with a local volunteer group and the Council's lead for refugees, the team at Retinue supported a group of 154 Afghan' predominantly women and young people with a donation of several hundred brand new hijabs, traditional dresses and over 100 pairs of children's shoes.
